**Local Missions:** It's a new year and there are again four local mission grants (up to \$500 each) available to members of Hope or someone directly associated with a member of Hope. The local mission grants are funded by Hope and are intended to encourage and aid members in actively pursuing helping others. Past recipients have gone on mission trips with a group or individually (ex. Habitat for Humanity, NEWLHS trips), provided services for those in need (medical, laundry), quilting (Lutheran World Relief and local), fundraising for a friend with medical needs, providing a meal and activity for veterans, etc. The grants are similar to Thrivent Action Teams - not a direct donation to a cause but meant to support an active participant. Applications are available in the church office and are reviewed at church council meetings on the second Monday of each month.
