Youth News

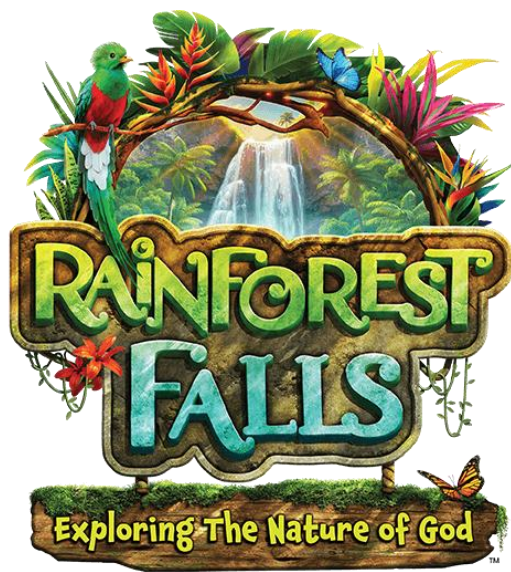

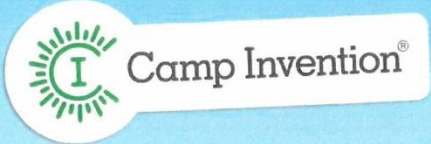

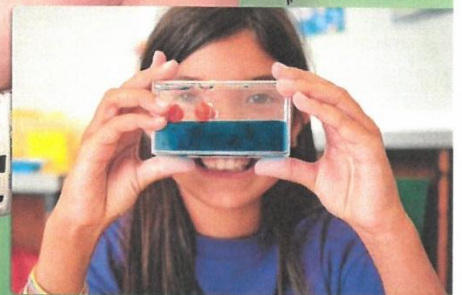
